#### 3. TALKS IN SPECIAL SESSIONS

Abstracts should be submitted as LaTeX files. However, in this LaTeX file please do NOT include `begindocument` and `enddocument` commands, do not utilize aliases and do not load special fonts. (Fonts will be loaded globally, once and for all, at the very end. The server uses LaTeX to html, and the presentation on the Internet will sometimes be far from optimal, but the form of the abstracts in the booklet will be much better.)

**Titel:** Quantum computers: mogelijkheden en onmogelijkheden.

### Abstract

Begin jaren tachtig merkte de beroemde Nobelprijswinnaar Richard Feynman op dat simulaties van quantum-mechanische systemen op klassieke computers bijzonder moeilijk kunnen zijn en hij trok daaruit het vermoeden dat een computer die zelf gestoeld was op quantummechanische principes misschien veel krachtiger zou kunnen zijn dan een klassieke computer. Dit basisidee is stilletjes verder uitgewerkt geworden maar het brak pas echt door toen Peter Shor in 94 met een algoritme op de proppen kwam om met behulp van quantumsystemen gehele getallen in priemfactoren te splitsen en dit in polynomiale tijd (polynomiaal in functie van het aantal digits); het beste klassieke algoritme, de number field sieve, heeft nog altijd exponentiele complexiteit.

In deze lezing geven we, na een 1-minuutsinleiding in de quantummechanica, een korte historische schets van de ontwikkelingen in het domein van de quantum computing tot en met nu, zowel op theoretisch vlak (algoritmen) als op experimenteel vlak (technologieën, implementaties). We bespreken wat de belangrijkste problemen zijn bij het bouwen van een quantumcomputer, wat je met een quantumcomputer zal kunnen doen, maar we pogen ook het onderwerp min of meer te demystifieren door te tonen wat je er niet mee kunt doen. Om deze lezing te kunnen volgen is slechts een absoluut minimum aan wis- en natuurkundige voorkennis vereist.

*In studying discrete dynamics in  $\mathbb{R}^2$  or continuous dynamics in  $\mathbb{R}^3$ , even locally, a variety of techniques have to be used. During the course week we want to present interesting tools dealing with different aspect. We also aim at bringing together PhD-students and young post-docs in dynamical systems from all over Europe. The organization is mainly supported by the TMR-network "Singularities of differential equations and foliations" (<http://www.sedf.ups-tlse.fr>) and the ESF-programme "Probabilistic methods in non hyperbolic dynamics (PRODYN)" (<http://www.prodyn.org>). PhD-students and young post-docs from the participating countries can obtain a financial support. They have to contact the local responsables.*

The organization takes place at the Limburgs Universitair Centrum (Diepenbeek, Belgium). Information on the LUC, and on how to reach it, can be found on the web at <http://www.luc.ac.be/>.

The participation fee for the course week amounts to 100 Euro. A financial support, consisting of a fixed amount per day and a limited amount of travel expenses, can be provided to the participants belonging to the TMR-network "Singularities of differential equations and foliations", as well as to the participants from the countries participating in the ESF-programme "Probabilistic methods in non-hyperbolic dynamics (PRODYN)".
